Will making these building improvements improve student performance?



"MEASURABLE SIGNIFICANT MAY BE THE OUTCOMES **RESULT OF** LEAST

Not possible to answer definitively...

Many variables that influence a student's performance level including...

- ✓ Did they receive appropriate early learning opportunities?
- ✓ Do they have a supportive home environment?
- ✓ Does their socio-economic status give them the best opportunity for learning?
- \checkmark Are they bringing adverse childhood experiences (ACEs) into the classroom?

The Challenge Question

Will making these building improvements improve student performance?



We know if students are feeling safe, comfortable, calm, connected and supported then more effective learning can happen.

So, the question is not: "does the building improvement academic performance?"


Reframe the question: "does the building provide the environment and experience to allow a student to learn and for teachers to do their best work?"




