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TYPES OF ENTITIES

► STATE ENTITY VS NON STATE ENTITY

- STATE ENTITY ANY U S STATE ENTITY OR TERRITORY AS WELL AS ANY STATE AGENCY OR INSTRUMENTALITY OF THAT STATE OR TERRITORY
- NON-STATE ENTITY LOCAL GOVERNMENTS, TRIBAL GOVERNMENTS, INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION, HOSPITALS, HOUSES OF WORSHIP AND PRIVATE NONPROFIT ORGANIZATIONS

TYPES OF FEMA REIMBURSEMENTS

- REIMBURSEMENTS AS A RESULT OF DAMAGES OR LOSSES SUFFERED FROM THE DISASTER
- PROVIDING TRANSPORTATION EVACUATION PRIOR TO OR AFTER THE DISASTER
- PROVIDING SHELTER FOR EVACUEES INCLUDING HOUSING & FOOD

- KNOW THE RULES NON-STATE ENTITIES MUST FOLLOW ALL APPLICABLE LOCAL AND STATE LAW AS WELL AS FEDERAL RULES FOR PROCURING GOODS & SERVICES TO BE REIMBURSED
- WRITTEN PROCUREMENT PROCEDURES WHICH COMPLY WITH ALL THE RULES
- ► WRITTEN OVERTIME POLICIES

- CREATE PRE-QUALIFIED LISTS OF VENDORS THAT MAY BE USED TO SATISFY PROCUREMENT NEEDS BEFORE, DURING, AND AFTER THE DISASTER
 - ► THESE VENDORS WILL HAVE
 - REASONABLE PRICES
 - ▶ QUALITY GOODS & SERVICES
 - NECESSARY QUALIFICATIONS AND TECHNICAL & FINANCIAL ABILITIES
 - ► A RECORD OF INTEGRITY AND GOOD STANDING

- AWARD PREPOSITIONED CONTRACTS OR ADVANCED CONTRACTS BEFORE A DISASTER OR INCIDENT
 - ALLOWS A DELIBERATE PROCUREMENT PROCESS OUTSIDE OF PRESSURE & IMMEDIATE DEMANDS OF DISASTER
 - ENSURES THAT ENTITY HAS CONTRACTORS READY TO PERFORM WORK

- SELECT YOUR PROCUREMENT METHOD AND CONTRACT TYPE
- INCLUDE REQUIRED CONTRACT PROVISIONS AND DETERMINE IF BONDING IS REQUIRED
- **EVALUATE BIDS OR PROPOSALS**
- ► VERIFY CONTRACTOR SELECTED AT WWW.SAM.GOV
- MAINTAIN OVERSIGHT OF CONTRACTOR OR VENDOR THRU THE ENTIRE PROCESS

Engaging in a sole-sourcing procurement without documenting emergency or exigent situation

5 Not making and documenting efforts to take all "affirmative steps"

> Not including the required contract clauses

9 Awarding a contract to contractors that are suspended or debarred

Avoiding these obstacles can speed up your road to recovery

Top 10 Procurement under Grants Mistakes

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Not performing detailed **price or cost analysis** for procurements above \$250,000

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Continuing work under a sole-source contract after the urgent need has ended

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Awarding a "time-andmaterials" contract without a ceiling price and documenting why no other contract type is suitable

Awarding a "cost-pluspercentage-of-cost" or "percentage-ofconstruction-cost" contract

Not **documenting all steps of a procurement** to answer questions that could arise months or years later
